**The Hants & Dorset ARA was founded in 1903 and originally consisted of seven Clubs – Bournemouth, Poole, Weymouth, Southsea, Southampton, Shanklin and Bournemouth YMCA. The Association was formed with an agreed split from CARA, who had since 1893 administered all rowing along the South Coast from Herne Bay to Weymouth – but increased travelling expenses made the area too large for Clubs to support all Regattas and there was a consequent drop in entries.**

The 2020 AGM of the Association was postponed because of the Coronavirus (COVID-19). The Existing Executive Officers of the Association agreed to remain in place until an AGM of the Association could be held – this took place on 27<sup>th</sup> March, 2021

## **Hon. Secretaries Report on the 2020 Season.**

The Global Pandemic had a devastating impact on the Hants & Dorset ARA 2020 season with all but one of the planned events cancelled – including the South Coast Championships scheduled to be hosted by the Association at the Royal Victoria Park, Netley, Southampton.

The only event to take place was an early season Head Race organised by BTC on the 14<sup>th</sup> March – just over a week before the country went into its First National Lockdown after which no further events could be held.

The situation eased a little later in the year and Clubs were able to carry out limited land training and some water activity in line with extensive guidance provided by British Rowing. But by November the Country was in full lockdown once again and nearly all activity had to stop. This has continued in to the New Year and at the time of writing it seems likely that some restrictions will start to be lifted by the end of March.

During this period the Hants & Dorset Clubs used a variety of innovative ideas to keep them members active and engaged and all are to be congratulated for their efforts.

The provision of Covid-19 local authority Grants did much to ease the financial burden on Clubs.

The Association Clubs did register their oarsman/women as usual in spite of there being no competition although the numbers inevitable dropped with no additional registration added during the year. The total of oarsman/women registered was 609 as opposed to 744 in 2019. The largest Club was Christchurch with 123 registered followed by Itchen Imperial with 67.

The Association was unable to hold their Annual General Meeting in March, 2020 – and all Executive Officers agreed to continue in their positions until an AGM could be arranged. The Association did hold a successful Autumn Council Meeting via Zoom in November 2020 and the Executive officers met, again via Zoom, on monthly basis from July, 2020 to discuss issues of concern to the Association. The Race Officials Meeting in January, 2021 and the Safety Meeting in February, 2021 also took place via Zoom – with a Zoom Association AGM planned for 27<sup>th</sup> March, 2021.

It is with deep regret that I have to report of the passing of three long serving members of Association Clubs – Mike Green of Christchurch, Colin Fagan of Lymington and John Forrest of Shanklin Sandown.

With the roll-out of the Covid-19 vaccine we anticipate a relaxation in lockdown measures and we hope that competitive racing will be able to start soon and that we can have a successful 2021 season.

## OBITUARIES

### Colin Fagan 1940 – 2021



LYMINGTON Rowing Club president Colin Fagan, who spent more than two decades with the organisation died aged 81. Colin, who joined the club in the early 1990s, coached both crews and individuals to success at regional, national and world levels. He was also instrumental in securing funding to enable the club to relocate to its current facility within the town's Lymington Shores development. Alongside several other members of the club, he spent many years working with local developers and councils before finally securing the move from its former site at Nelson Place.

Colin was born in Beaconsfield in Buckinghamshire in 1939 and educated at Sir William Borlase School in Marlow, where he was introduced to rowing. He later joined the Marlow Rowing Club and went on to become captain. He married Mary in 1963 and they had two children: Katherine and Nicholas. In 1979 the family moved to Pilley where Colin continued in his role as a quantity surveyor and estimator. Arriving at Lymington Rowing Club, Colin took on coaching crews with his unique style, using simple analogies to describe complex movements in the stroke.

Colin worked closely with another club member to develop a new carbon fibre boat and mould, which was then taken up by a commercial boat builder who produced at least 30 boats from it for other clubs. Colin also had the foresight to set up an agreement with the boat builder for the club to receive commission for each boat taken from the mould, which resulted in much needed funds. He was always seen as being the senior coach and was inspirational not only with the crews he coached but also with the other coaches. "His methods and training regime soon spread through the club. This led to the club adopting a far more professional approach to its training and with it came success.

He also played a part in the wider rowing scene, as a long-standing member of the Wessex and South East Regional Rowing Council. From 2005 Colin was also heavily involved in organising the South Coast Rowing Championships Regatta.

His passion for the sport was obvious and he never seemed to be happier than being out on the water, regardless of the weather, with loudhailer in hand, giving instruction to a crew. He was respected by all those who knew him. He was selfless, a true gentleman and an indispensable club member. He will be sadly missed."

### John Forrest 1943-2021



John joined Shanklin in the late 60s and became a keen oarsman, competing in fours, galleys and pairs for several years. He took part in the first IOW Hants & Dorset Regatta held by Ryde and Shanklin at Yaverland. He helped build the club house that was opened in 1975 and was then instrumental with organising the building and opening of the new boathouse in 2014.

After bringing up his family, John again took on positions in the club and

became Captain in the early 2000s and served on the committee until his death. He ran the Bar, was secretary for the Shanklin fundraising "150" club, served on the IOW Rowing Forum, was the "go to" person for boat and club maintenance, and generally any job that needed doing! Always willing to get any new member afloat, and encourage them, his stamina helping out on the beach and at regattas until well into his 70s was amazing.

John will be greatly missed by all members of the club both young and old, and his knowledge and work leave a huge void.

### **Mike Green 1937 -2020**



Mike Green, who passed away in early November, was a lifelong member of Christchurch Rowing Club and supporter to all wider organisations involved with rowing including the Hants & Dorset ARA, Wessex & South East Region, and British Rowing.

After attending Brocklehurst Grammar School he became an apprentice with de Havilland Aircraft Company and eventually became a company director of training with ITE Autotech.

Rowing was Mike's passion and he joined Christchurch Rowing Club in 1953 at the age of 16 - he was still coaching and an active member of the club and wider rowing organisations 67 years later.

Mike had a very successful rowing career winning the inaugural South Coast Senior Championship in 1957. This finished a remarkable season when they won the Hants and Dorset ARA Senior Championship, the Portsmouth Grand Challenge cup, the Daily Herald Trophy and the Inter Divisional Regatta held at Hereford. This made the crew probably the most successful crew in the country at the time. This was just the start.

Mike was Club Captain at Christchurch on 12 occasions and Club President seven times. He was President of the Hants and Dorset ARA in 1990 and 1991 and became British Rowing Divisional Representative and a member of the Wessex Regional Rowing Council.

Mike achieved British Rowing Gold Level Coach qualifications in 1979 and used his knowledge and skills to help individuals from young novices learning to row to those who went on to international level.

He was a volunteer at the World Rowing Junior Championships in 2011 and a Games Maker at the London 2012 Olympics. Mike was involved in many of the major decisions that has seen the club achieve success at every level in rowing ensuring the club always had some of the best facilities.

Mike became a Hants & Dorset race official and then used his experience to set the examination questions for new members of the officials' team, raising the standard to a very high level.

There are so many achievements in Mike's life that it is difficult to list them all. He will be missed by everyone who came into his life and by the rowing community everywhere.



The Hants & Dorset Amateur Rowing Association was founded in the old premises of the West Quay Amateur Regatta Club on the 18th July 1903. The Association originally consisted of seven clubs - Bournemouth, Poole, Weymouth, Southsea, Southampton, Shanklin and Bournemouth YMCA. The Association was formed with an agreed split from the Coast ARA, who since 1893 administered all rowing along the South Coast from Herne Bay to Weymouth. Before then it was the South Coast ARA who administered South Coast rowing from the early 1850s till 1893, when the Coast ARA was founded - but increased travelling expenses made the area too large for clubs to support all regattas and there was a consequent drop in entries. The Hants & Dorset is affiliated to British Rowing and today has 13 affiliated clubs: Coalporters Southampton, B.T.C (Southampton), Itchen Imperial, Southampton, Newport, Ryde, Shanklin & Sandown, Southsea, Lymington, Christchurch, Bournemouth, Poole, and Worthing.

The Hants & Dorset is run by the officers of the association: President, Chairperson, Hon. Secretary and Hon. Treasurer and also its Life Vice Presidents, Vice Presidents, and Race Officials who are usually members of the affiliated clubs. Each club has two delegates that are entitled to vote in association meetings as well as their officials & officers etc. There is a delegates meeting held in October and AGM held in March each year.

Each year the clubs of the H&D compete in a series of regattas to race for an overall championship. In the beginning there were close to 40 regattas each year. This gradually decreased and today there are 13 regattas as well as supporting head races and under 16 events. The 13 championship regattas are spread over the summer months, usually from May to August, and this is where clubs can claim championship points. The most points for a crew/club will win the championship and be presented with a medal at the presentation dinner.

Below is a list of individual and club championships the Hants & Dorset regattas offer. As well as these there are also open events such as Masters 50 Fours and Double Scull which are offered but no points can be claimed. Over the next few pages, you will find the history of all previous Hants and Dorset Championships awarded as well as a list of all past persons to hold office for the Hants & Dorset.

# SOUTHAMPTON COALPORTERS ROWING CLUB

## Uncle Sam v The Coalies, Wednesday 17 September 1884

Since their stay in our waters the men of the United States frigate Lancaster have given some remarkable exhibitions of their prowess as oarsmen, and in their smart little cutter "Uncle Sam" have carried everything before them at all the recent regattas, and it had become to be regarded as a noteworthy tradition on board the American flagship that their crew had never experienced defeat. The Coal Porters challenged them to a match: the stakes were £30 a side, the Coal Porters subscribing £10 out of their own not very heavy-metalled pockets.

This challenge was looked upon as a bold stroke, and there was not wanting an army of croakers who, professing sympathy with the home crew, yet predicted the success of the Americans as a certainty – "science against strength" was the favourite motto. The Lancaster crew, whose boat, the "Uncle Sam" is said to have been built exclusively for racing purposes at a cost of £200, pulled 14 oars and a coxswain.

The Coal Porters were placed at a disadvantage, because, unhappily, their club funds had not yet permitted the purchase of a boat of their own. Mr Harry Hall, of the Castle Tap, came to the rescue, and having purchased a disused service cutter for £4 from among the condemned stores at Portsmouth Dockyard, placed it at the disposal of the Coalies, who proudly christened their smart looking craft the "Black Diamond." The "locals" were allowed 18 oars and a coxswain, as their boat was about twice the size of their rivals' boat.

The course covered a distance of a little more than five nautical miles, extending from a couple of mark boats moored between the Royal Pier and HMS Trincomalee, down to a couple of American flag marks moored opposite the Netley Hospital shore. The Yankees appeared by far the smartest and most "fit" of the two, and with their disciplined bearing, their neat uniforms and bandaged hands, as well as their elegantly designed cutter, certainly looked most like winning.

The Coal Porters, though possessing everything that was requisite in the shape of muscular development and sheer physical endurance, created at first but an indifferent impression in consequence of the absurd inequalities of their boat as compared with that of their opponents.

Punctually at three o'clock the boats were got into line, when the starter – Mr Burbage – amid general silence gave the word "Are you ready? – Go!" Image 1884 Coalporters v USS Lancaster

The Coalies, who upon stripping evidently meant business, took a decided advantage from the start, and struck out with a good, bold stroke at 39 to the minute, the Americans pulling at a steady, slogging pace of 38 strokes. The whole of what followed may be accurately characterised as a procession of two boats, in which the local crew maintained and ultimately increased its lead to the close.

At the time of reaching of reaching the Itchen lightship, at the mouth of the Docks, the Coal Porters were pulling in really splendid condition, the men having by this time thoroughly settled down to their work. The Diamonds, warming to the work, gained quite half a length more as Weston Church was breasted. Down the river the scene was a very animated one. The ship's company of the Lancaster had manned the yards, trucks, ladders, bow-sprit and jib-boom, but not a sound was heard as the two boats pulled by.

The Coal Porters quietly gained a length, and after leaving the Lancaster flagship shot away under the bows of the Royal mail steamship Don, which was receiving her latest mails amid passengers prior to leaving on a

voyage to the West Indies, then struck out into the channel of the south shore. When it was seen that the Black Diamonds had such a handsome lead a lusty cheer went up from the ship.

Mr Pearce, the coxswain of the "Black Diamond," upon reaching well up the Netley shore, stripped to the waist, his boat then leading by nearly a quarter of a mile. They went round their mark abeam of HMS Hector in exactly 25 minutes from the start, and about 47 seconds ahead of the Americans, who cut the turn very fine, and had to up their starboard oars to prevent a foul.

With a young flood in their favour the leading crew soon made apparent the advantage of being round first, and pulling steady stroke of 40 to the minute as far as the Platform – the Americans going up pulled an average of 38 – they increased this to 44, which they maintained to the finish.

Every coin of advantage from which the race could be seen being occupied, and as the Black Diamonds rowed proudly in to win, apparently as fresh as when they started, a perfect roar of cheering went up from thousands of throats, which was taken up by those on board the innumerable craft which crowded round the finishing point.

The Coal Porters won by two minutes, the time of the race being 42m 47s, and when the verdict was pronounced they hoisted from the stern sheets a handsome ensign, bearing a lion rampant, presented to them by Mr Wolff, of the High Street

## **POOLE ROWING CLUB Sweeping All Before Them**

The Senior Crew for most of that period was Gilbert Saunders, William Puddy, Denise Keene, Jonny Matthews (stroke) and A. Condon (cox), as it is engraved on the Oakley Shield, and during that time knew no equal. Throughout this book I have attempted to avoid regurgitating the simple list of club results for each year, but such were the exploits of this crew that it is well worth listing their magnificent efforts here, as recorded in the club annual reports.

**1911** – ‘The racing crews competed at Cowes, Bournemouth, Weymouth and Poole Regatta, winning six first prizes, six seconds and one third, including the Hants & Dorset Senior League Championship; and the South Coast Challenge Cup.’ In this instance the report includes all the club’s successes but it can easily be assumed that to gain the two main prizes most of those first places belonged to the Senior Crew.

**1912** – ‘The season has been one of the most successful in the history of the Club. The Senior Racing Crew having competed on sixteen occasions, and we are glad to say they won on fourteen of them of them. We competed at the following places: Bournemouth, Southsea, Ryde, Southampton, Newport, Cowes, Weymouth, Poole and Exeter, and are the present holders for the year of the following Trophies. The Oakley Challenge Shield, the Dudley Ward Cup, the Leon Emmanuel Cup, the Lancaster Cup, the Veterans Cup, the South Coast Challenge Cup, the Hants & Dorset League Championship Cup. The Junior Crew competed at Bournemouth, Weymouth and Poole, winning one first and two seconds, also the Hants & Dorset Junior League Championship.’

**1913** – ‘The season has again been a most successful one. The Senior Crew competed on sixteen occasions, and we are glad to say won fifteen of them of them. We competed at the following places: Ventnor, Ryde, Newport, Southampton, Cowes, Weymouth, Swanage and Poole, winning first prizes at the regattas held at the five last named places, and are holders for the present year of the following Trophies:- The Oakley Challenge Shield, Dudley Ward Cup, Lancaster Cup, Veterans Cup, Steep Hill Castle Challenge Cup, the South Coast Challenge Cup, the Hants & Dorset League Championship Cup. The Junior Crew competed at the Bournemouth, Southampton, Swanage, Weymouth and Poole Regattas, winning one first, two seconds and one third prize.’

There is no reason to suspect that Poole’s Senior Crew would not have added even more glory to the list as they had already retained the Oakley Shield in 1914 before the declaration of The Great War.

From a racing point of view as was said early it appears Denis Keene never returned to the club after the war, but the remaining three members of the senior crew did and they were joined by L Miles in the bow and W Wills in the coxswain’s seat. Not surprisingly very little racing took place in that first year with the crew only travelling to Southampton Coalporters regatta and hosting two regattas at Poole. At one of the latter events the club retained the Oakley Shield and at the former the Dudley Ward Cup which having also won it in 1912 and 1913 gave them three wins in succession and therefore the cup now became the property of Poole Rowing Club. The club continued to offer the cup as the trophy for an invitation race between the Quays at Poole, until 1957 when the club presented the cup to the South Coast Championship committee to be used as the trophy for the Men’s Junior Championship, for which it is still used today.



## RYDE ROWING CLUB

### Three Consecutive Men's Senior Fours South Coast Championship

Ryde's most successful period at the South Coast Championships began in 1985 when their Men's Senior Four consisting of - Russell Page, Mark Singleton, Nick Pike, John Pike and Cox - Nicky Catton- in the same season as the Club won its first Hants & Dorset Senior Fours points and the Association Championship. The crew went on to win one of the closest ever Championship races in an epic struggle with host Club Hearne Bay a race which is rightly remembered as a classic from the following report by the late Arthur Chatfield, Hants & Dorset Association Secretary at the time relates - *"On a bleak and Cold Herne Bay coastline the supporting events gave little to enthuse about and the Regatta needed a lift. The Senior Championship event provided the answer with a memorable race and a superlative performance from two crews, Ryde and Herne Bay that will live long in the memory. By halfway on this superb 2000 meters straight course, Herne Bay racing with all the flair of a host club giving a party, had established a three-length lead and appeared indestructible. Christchurch and Ryde in that order were the nearest challengers. Within 500 meters of the finish Ryde on the outside gave notice of intent by raising the strike to an incredible forty. Herne Bay responded both crews leaving Christchurch for dead. At 200 meters Ryde had reduced the lead to a length and were throbbing on all four cylinders, power was but part of their ploy, perfect timing and swing gave them the impression of being mechanized, hands steady as rocks, eyes drilled on the neck in front, it was perfection, they were gaining every stroke on a Herne Bay crew giving a repeat performance of perfection. Within 50 meters they were level, Herne Bay in desperation raised their strike yet again and inched to the front as a rogue wave raised the bows of both boats horrifying the watching supporters, but neither crew faltered. Courage was now the name of the game and Ryde were not found wanting as they threw their bodies forward with a last ditch effort that gave them the verdict of three feet at the line. The immediate silence on the crowded beach was indicative of having seen an epic."*

In 1986 the crew repeated their performance, with just a change of coxswain – Lee Rayment taking over from Nicky Catton, and far more convincingly. This was arguably the crew's best performance as the race was in the less familiar river boats, although the Club had purchased its own riverboat by this time.

The 1987 Regatta staged on the Isle of Wight and hosted by Ryde and Shanklin Rowing Clubs. The Senior Crew, unchanged from 1986, in a season that had seen them clinch a 3rd consecutive Hants & Dorset Senior Championship and qualify for Henley, won the Men's Senior Championship race, on home waters at Ryde, after a controversial dead heat and a re-row, from their great rivals BTC.
