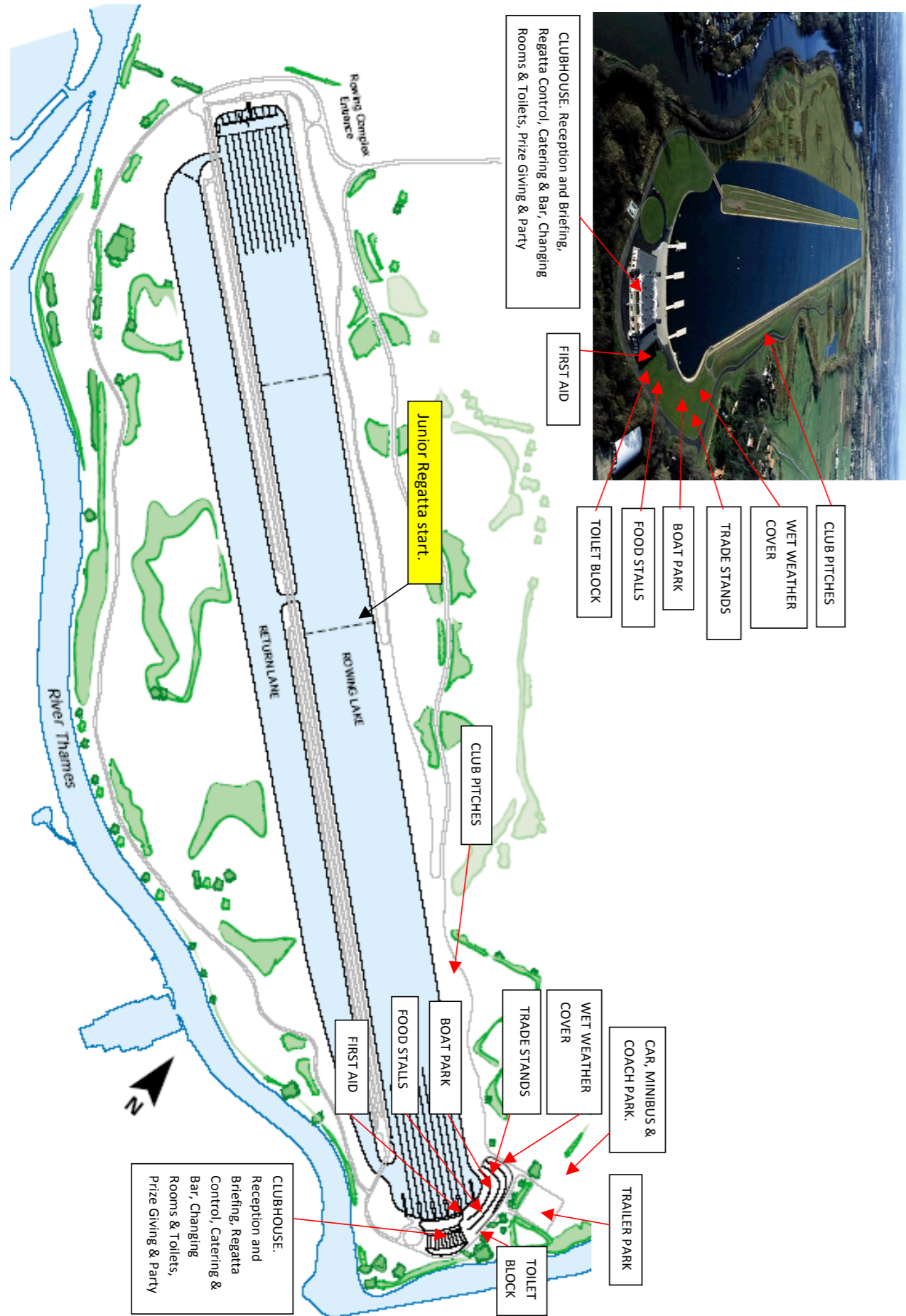

DORNEY LAKE!

Dorney Lake is an eight-lane, purpose built world-class Rowing Course and flat water canoeing centre owned by Eton College and opened in June, 2000 by Kate Hoey, MP, the then Minister for Sport. It is a magnificent, modern venue, set in a secluded 450 acre nature park near the River Thames.

In the late 1980's Eton College made the decision to build an international standard rowing course at Dorney and work started in 1996. The aim was to provide a much-needed training and racing facility in Southern England, not just for the boys of the school but also for the use of International and Club rowers alike. It has been designed with international events in mind and in addition to the rowing lake it offers a modern boathouse with boat storage and repair facilities, a gymnasium, changing, shower and toilet facilities, sports medicine facilities and conference/ reception and catering facilities. It has ample parking space and an excellent view of the course for spectators. As well as sporting activities Dorney Lake provides year-round corporate and private hospitality facilities. Functions from

12 to several thousand people can be accommodated, using any combination of land and water.

There is disabled access to all areas of the building.

Over one hundred schools and clubs now use its facilities. The £17 million project was financed by Eton College's foundation and the lake is operated by an independent charity called the Dorney Lake Trust Company and its subsidiary Dorney Lake Services Limited. 4,000,000 tonnes of gravel were extracted from the site during construction. Dorney Lake was the venue for a round of the World Cup in 2005 and the World Rowing Championships in 2006 and the World Junior Championships in 2011. It was the venue for both the rowing and flat-water canoeing events at the London 2012 Olympics.

Dorney Lake has been the venue for the South Coast Rowing Championships on two previous occasions - in 2007 and 2011 - both hosted by the Hants & Dorset ARA.

HISTORY OF THE SOUTH COAST ROWING CHAMPIONSHIPS REGATTA.

The South Coast Rowing Championships was the inspiration of Archie Fraser, of Westover & Bournemouth Rowing Club who had the idea of an event involving the three South Coast Rowing Associations - the Hants & Dorset ARA, (H&D ARA) the Coast ARA (CARA) and the West of England ARA (WEARA) - who would provide a champion in each class to compete in a "champion of champions" race at the end of the rowing season.

The first Championship Regatta was hosted by the Hants & Dorset ARA at Poole in 1957 where Christchurch were the winners of the first Senior event, for the Bideford Bowl, donated by the West of England ARA and BTC won both the Junior Senior and Junior Event. The following day officials from the three Associations met in Poole Yacht Club where it was decided that the Regatta should continue and be hosted by each Association in rotation. It was agreed that the host Association would provide six matched boats and include any supporting events of their own choice. The Hants & Dorset and Christchurch Rowing Clubs Toby Trowbridge was elected the first Chairman of what became the South Coast Council.

In the early years, there was a good deal of controversy between the Associations because of the differences in rules and because WEARA rowed in 36' river boats (now 42') but H&DARA and CARA Clubs used 30' staggered seat Coastal boats. However annual meetings of the representative South Coast Committee (now the South Coast Council) have established a set of acceptable rules and regatta format. The original three-year cycle was changed to a four-year cycle with the regatta being held in WEARA every other year to counteract the disadvantage that WEARA crews suffered having to row in Coastal Boats - although this reverted to a three-year cycle again in 2011 following a proposal from the West of England ARA. In 1967, it was stated that the cost of staging the South Coast Championship Regatta was £270 - today it is around £25,000!

Although the supporting events had often included ladies' races there was no Championship event until 1976 - and in 1992 a Junior Ladies Championship event was added - with a Veterans Championship added in 2004 bringing the total of Championship events to six.

The 50th Regatta was held at Dartmouth and hosted by the West of England Amateur Rowing Association and included a celebration Dinner on the Thursday evening before the Regatta, a row-past on Regatta day of some of those who had competed in the first Regatta in 1957 - and the inaugural Junior Regatta. To celebrate fifty years of the South Coast Championship Regatta a fascinating

book was produced with full results, including winning crew's names and anecdotes from all the Championship regattas held between 1957 and 2005 and this is recommended reading for those who are interested in the event and the history of rowing. The books authors were the Coast ARA's Phil Challen and the Hants & Dorset ARA's Denny Woodford and the book is now available as a free download from the Hants & Dorset ARA's SCC web site - see the SCC section at www.hdara.co.uk.

Since 2006 there has always been a Junior Regatta staged - either on the same day or on the Sunday after the main regatta - and once on the Friday before - and this has proved to be increasing popular - although the numbers of events staged are restricted when the Championships are staged at a Coastal venue.

In 2007, it was the Hants & Dorset ARA's turn to host the Championships once again and they took the brave and at the time rather controversial decision to stage the event at the new, purpose built, international standard venue of Dorney Lake, Eton, where the 2012 Olympic Regatta was staged. Their decision was justified when the event proved to be one of the most successful and arguably the fairest ever staged prompting the Association to return to Dorney Lake for the 2011 Championship Regatta. The deteriorating weather conditions during the day had a significant impact on the 2013 Regatta, hosted by CARA, at Deal - where for the first time in its fifty-eight-year history - two Championship events - the Men's Junior Senior Fours and the Ladies Junior Fours were not completed.

The next Championships to be hosted by the Hants & Dorset ARA in 2014 saw a return to a coastal location with Swanage the chosen venue - but once again the weather had a significant impact with the second days racing - involving the Juniors and small boats. cancelled - although all the Championships events were completed on the Saturday - along with some of the Junior events. Although a very successful regatta was staged at the coastal venue of Herne Bay in excellent conditions in 2016 following the disruption to the 2014 event at Swanage the Hants & Dorset ARA have opted to return to Dorney Lake once again for this year's Championship Regatta - and many feel that this or a similar venue represent the future for the Championships as it pretty much guarantees that the event is not influenced by the weather - which has so often affected this event.

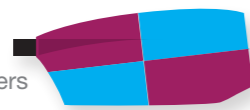

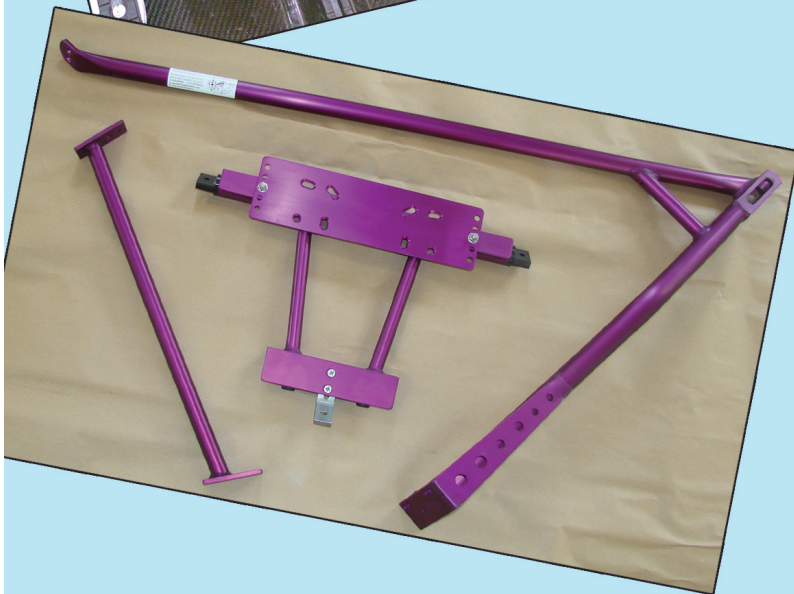
